- 5. Instant messages (using AOL, MSN, Yahoo or other instant messenger programs)
- 6. Online chat room advertisements
- 7. Guestbook or Website Forum postings
- 8. Facsimile Solicitations
- 9. Facebook
- 10. MySpace
- 11. Twitter
